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## TRICK TRAINING II

### 5 Week Class

North County (near Lake Hodges, W. Bernardo/Pomerado Rd exit)

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Play the piano</b></li><li>• <b>Turn on and Off a Light switch</b></li><li>• <b>Retrieve of an object</b></li><li>• <b>Hold</b></li><li>• <b>Come Easy → Wait</b></li><li>• <b>Paws Up</b></li><li>• <b>Kick a Ball</b></li><li>• <b>Cross Front Legs</b></li></ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Build on distance and next steps with the 17 Tricks from the Trick I Class</b></li><li>• <b>Combinations of Tricks and multiple dogs doing tricks at the same time (ie. a group rollover)</b></li><li>• <b>Ring a call bell</b></li><li>• <b>Distance Down, sit, stand</b></li></ul> |
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### Supplies needed for the Class:

- **CLICKER!**
- **Small child's play Piano/Keyboard (Target or Walmart)**
- **Second Leash -6 foot**
- **Desk call bell (Staples)**
- **"Easy" Button (Staples)**
- **Light Switch (I will supply)**
- **Soccer ball or Beach ball**
- **Circular ring to stabilize ball (I will supply)**
- **Lots of high value small yummy soft treats (ie. Mozzarella Cheese, Bil Jac, Zukes treats, hot dogs, chicken, Natural Balance, etc.) cut into small pieces the size of your ring finger nail. Use treats that do not crumble.**
- **Same supplies for Trick I (ie Skateboard, Hike It Box, Hula Hoop, 2 Marks)**
- **2 in. X 2 in. wooden bar (square not round) that is approximately 3 ½ feet long (I will supply). About the size of a Utility Bar jump bar.**
- **Mat or rug approx 2 feet X 2 feet**
- **Dowel (I will supply)**
